

#### **RABKA-ZDRÓJ**

Rabka-Zdrój is a popular spa town in Malopolska province, which is located in the Rabczanska Basin at an altitude of about 500 meters above sea level, near the famous Zakopianka (a road leading from Cracow to Zakopane). Rabka-Zdrój has become popular due to the therapeutic brine waters found here and its unique climatic qualities. Thanks to their presence, the town has been serving tourists as a spa and a place to relax for more than a century.



## Youth City Council of Rabka-Zdrój

The Rabka-Zdrój Youth City Council is a form of youth authority in local government of a consultative, advisory and initiative nature. Youth Council has been actively operating in Rabka-Zdrój since 2003 as a tool for practical teaching of young residents of Rabka-Zdrój and neighboring towns the processes of local government functioning and influence on decisions and undertakings at the local level.





#### **Family Picnic**

The Rabka-Zdrój Youth City Council in cooperation with the Rabka-Zdrój Municipal Office organised a Family Picnic for residents and tourists on 27 August 2022 as part of an ecological project, during which a lecture was given by an Ecoadvisor from the Municipal Office. In the fun zone, themed colouring books on water saving were distributed to children, in addition to a number of dance shows, a mini theatre performance for children and a DJ concert at the end of the event.















## SPRING CLEANING ACTION IN THE MUNICIPALITY

On the occasion of World Earth Day, the Mayor of Rabka-Zdrój Leszek Świder and the Rabka-Zdrój Youth City Council organised a cleaning action in the municipality, with numerous contributions from residents and local associations, schools and kindergartens. The aim of the action was to promote good, pro-environmental habits from an early age.



# DEBATE ON THE STATE OF AIR QUALITY

During the December session of the Rabka-Zdrój Youth City Council, a debate was organised on the state of air quality in the Rabka-Zdrój municipality. Speakers at the debate included a representative of the Krakow Smog Alarm, the Rabka-Zdrój Municipal Office's Eco-Advisor, the Chief of the Rabka-Zdrój Municipal Police and the Mayor of Rabka-Zdrój Leszek Świder.



#### **ELECTRIC BUSES**

The Rabka-Zdrój Town Hall has secured funding for the purchase of two electric city buses, which would in future serve to get residents around the town in an environmentally friendly way.



#### CAMPAIGN "SEE WHAT YOU BREATHE. SEE HOW TO CHANGE IT"

As part of the campaign "See what you breathe. See how to change it', mobile lungs were set up in Rabka-Zdrój to show the current state of air quality. The campaign aimed not only to show the existing air pollution, but also to urge people to act, i.e. to insulate their homes and replace old inefficient boilers and cookers.




## URBAN FIELD GAME

The Rabka-Zdrój Youth City Council in cooperation with the Rabka-Zdrój Town Hall and the Centre for Culture, Sports and Promotion in Rabka-Zdrój organised a Field Town Game in the Spa Park, in which around 100 people participated. The players' task was to find questions hidden in the park and answer them. Competitors had to demonstrate good orientation skills, logical thinking and motor skills.



### YOUTH DIAGNOSIS

The Europe4Youth Association, in cooperation with the Rabka-Zdrój Youth Town Council, has created the Rabka-Zdrój Youth Municipality Development Strategy for 2023-2030, which includes improving environmental awareness among young people and creating ecological public transport.







## THE "CLEAN AIR AROUND US" PROGRAMME

It was implemented in cooperation with the District Sanitary and Epidemiological Station in New Targ. The aim of the programme was to reduce children's exposure to passive smoking, to increase knowledge of the effects of cigarette smoking, to develop children's awareness of how to deal with situations in which other people smoke cigarettes in front of them, as well as a series of five antismoking didactic classes for children. On the occasion of Earth Day, we organised an "ECOLOGICAL MARCH" on the Orkana Estate, which was met with great interest by local residents.



# PROJECT "WITH GIFTS OF NATURE THE WORLD IS NOT BLEAK"

The main aim of the ecological-art project was to shape proenvironmental attitudes, stimulate the creativity of children and teachers and introduce the idea of zero waste. Doing the various tasks was always a lot of fun for the children. Thanks to the variety of tasks, the children had the opportunity to develop their creative and imaginative thinking and realise individual and collective creative expression.






#### "I KNOW AND UNDERSTAND.I CARE ABOUT NATURE" PROGRAMME

# ENVIRONMENTAL FASHION SHOW ON THE OCCASION OF WORLD EARTH DAY

Every year on 22 April we celebrate Earth Day all over the world, and on this occasion, at Primary School No. 1 we commemorate this day with a school eco-fashion show, which took place on 21 April. At the end, they made beeswax candles. Each participant received a certificate, a booklet and increased their knowledge.



#### EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES - WORLD EARTH DAY






### **ECOLOGICAL COMPETITION**






#### ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVITIES AT THE PONICE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Ponice Primary School has joined the **Educational Anti-Smog Network** programme, which carries out a number of activities to promote clean air. Part of the programme included the installation of a smog sensor (an electronic board with pollution measurements) and the participation of pupils in the Anti-Smog Olympics. Twice a year, the school organises a cyclical Clean Ponice action (as part of the Clean Up the World and Earth Day campaigns), which involves clearing litter, not only from the school grounds, but from the entire village. In the spring, as part of this action, the school's next graduates plant their tree, this year it was a lime tree. Pupils took part in an action to collect used batteries organised by the BIOSYSTEM Foundation.
